Scene I

Sailor
(he begins his harangue by pointing an accusing finger)

Here's the answer you're searching for!(quickly turns and tacks up the poster on the curtain...the poster contains a large picture of a grinning sailor and the legend, JOIN THE NAVY...)....that's it...JOIN THE NAVY and free the world.. sign up for your country..our first line of defense... JOIN THE UNITED STATES NAVY!

Marine
(enters at stage right with a recruiting poster and addresses the audience in much the same manner as the sailor)

Do you want this war won? What part will you play in our victory? I have your answer...I'm the man for whom you've been waiting...and here it is!(quickly tacks up the poster of a smiling marine with the legend of JOIN THE MARINES...)..that's it..JOIN THE MARINES...the best soldiers of the land and sea...the history-making ~~leathernecks~~... JOIN THE UNITED STATES MARINES!

Soldier
(enters at the left with his recruiting poster)

Here I am men, and it's your lucky day for I'm not selling anything...I'm giving something away..and it's something you all want..do your part to smash the Axis..Here's your big chance..(tacks his poster with its sailing soldier and legend of JOIN THE ARMY..) ..that's it..JOIN THE ARMY...the best soldiers in the world...don't rush me men..step right up..who'll be the first to join... JOIN THE UNITED STATES ARMY!
